Dear Mr. Guinn:

In reference to our phone conversation on March 13, 1980, I am supplying the following information for your consideration. This should answer any remaining questions which you may have with regard to the training of personnel in the operation of the irradiator.

Personnel who will be trained, at the time of installation of the irradiator, by Atomic Energy of Canada, Ltd. will be Dr. Lloyd Cook, Ms. Donna Lien, Ms. Linda Schroeder, and Dr. David Miller. They will be instructed in the operation of the equipment, how to check the safety interlocks on the equipment, what to do in the event of an emergency, and how to maintain the equipment in proper working condition. No one else will be allowed to use or operate the equipment unless they have first been instructed by one of these individuals and have proved that they can handle the equipment safely. A written record of all individuals who have been authorized to use the equipment will be maintained.

Emergency procedures will be posted in the immediate area of the irradiator. These procedures will include phone numbers of those responsible parties and where they can be reached in the event of an emergency.

Hopefully this information will clarify those questions which arose in our application. It would be helpful if you could expedite this application since it is not possible for us to process transactions with Atomic Energy of Canada, Ltd. without our license. Thank you for your assistance.
