Charter for the Ad Hoc Committee for
Review of Enforcement Policy

1. Official Designation

Advisory Committee on Enforcement Policy.

2. Objectives and Scope of Activities and Duties

The purpose of the NRC enforcement policy is to promote and protect the radiological health and safety of the public, including employees' health and safety, the common defense and security, and the environment. The Committee will review the current NRC enforcement policy to determine whether it achieved the purposes defined in Section I of Appendix C of 10 CFR Part 2 and provide the Commission with recommendations on any changes to the policy it believes advisable.

3. Time Period

The time period is expected to be 4-6 months.

4. Agency to whom the Committee Reports

United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

5. Agency Responsible for Providing Necessary Support

United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

6. Duties

As set forth in Item 2 above.

7. Cost

- a. \$20,000 (allowed expenses, including travel and per diem).

8. Estimated Number of Meetings


