This is to verify that Major Aida P. Ronquillo, MC, USAR, SSN 354-50-4199, completed a one-year post-graduate Fellowship in Radiation Oncology at the Naval Regional Medical Center, San Diego, on 30 June 1982. Her Fellowship had begun on 17 June 1981.


During this fellowship year, Major Ronquillo participated actively in all case review and teaching conferences and assumed responsibility under supervision for the evaluation and treatment of cancer patients utilizing superficial x-ray therapy, cobalt 60 teletherapy, intracavitary radium, and strontium in the form of an eye applicator.

At that time our Division was seeing and evaluating approximately 900 new patients per year and accepting for treatment about 450. We were doing approximately 30 intracavitary implants a year at that time.

Major Ronquillo was involved in the discussions concerning the majority of these patients by her attending and active participation in case review conferences.

It was not a requirement at that time that a record of the specific numbers and types of cases being treated under the supervision of any individual physician be maintained.
