Radiological Emergency Preparedness Plans for the Big Rock  
Point Nuclear Power Station

Attached are two copies of the Exercise Report of the May 21, 1985, joint exercise of the offsite radiological emergency preparedness plans for the Big Rock Point Nuclear Power Station. This exercise involved partial participation for the State of Michigan and full participation for Charlevoix and Emmet Counties. The report dated July 24, 1985, was prepared by Region V of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

Although there were Category B deficiencies observed at the exercise, they did not seriously detract from the overall demonstrated capability to protect the health and safety of the public. The State is preparing a schedule of corrective actions. As soon as they are received, we will send you a copy. However, since there were no identified impediments to protecting the public health and safety during the exercise, the approval under FEMA Rule 44 CFR 350 will remain in effect.
