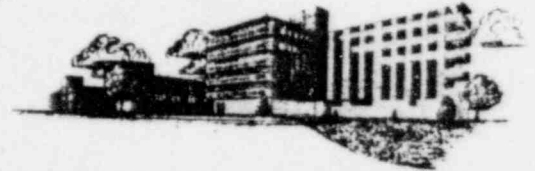

10. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Parts 11, 21, 22 and 41 of the Texas Regulations for Control of Radiation.
11. Radioactive material shall be used by Edward L. Koger, M.D.
12. The individual designated to perform the functions of Radiation Safety Officer for activities covered by this license is Edward L. Koger, M.D.

13. Unless otherwise specified by a specific condition of this license, radioactive material to be administered to humans shall be procured from a licensed nuclear pharmacy or from a supplier approved by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for the manufacture or distribution of such products.
14. The licensee shall report any irregularities to the Agency associated with identification, labeling, quality or assay of any radiopharmaceutical received under the authority of this license.
15. A record shall be maintained for inspection by the Agency at the Carrollton Medical Center of each nuclear medicine procedure performed using a mobile scanning service. The record shall include the date and time the mobile scanning service was directed by the licensee to perform the nuclear medicine procedure, location, patient's name, procedure performed, radiopharmaceutical prescribed, dosage prescribed, and name of on-site physician who supervised the dose administration.
16. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use the radioactive material authorized by this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated October 20, 1978, and all correspondence amending the application which results in an amendment to the license.

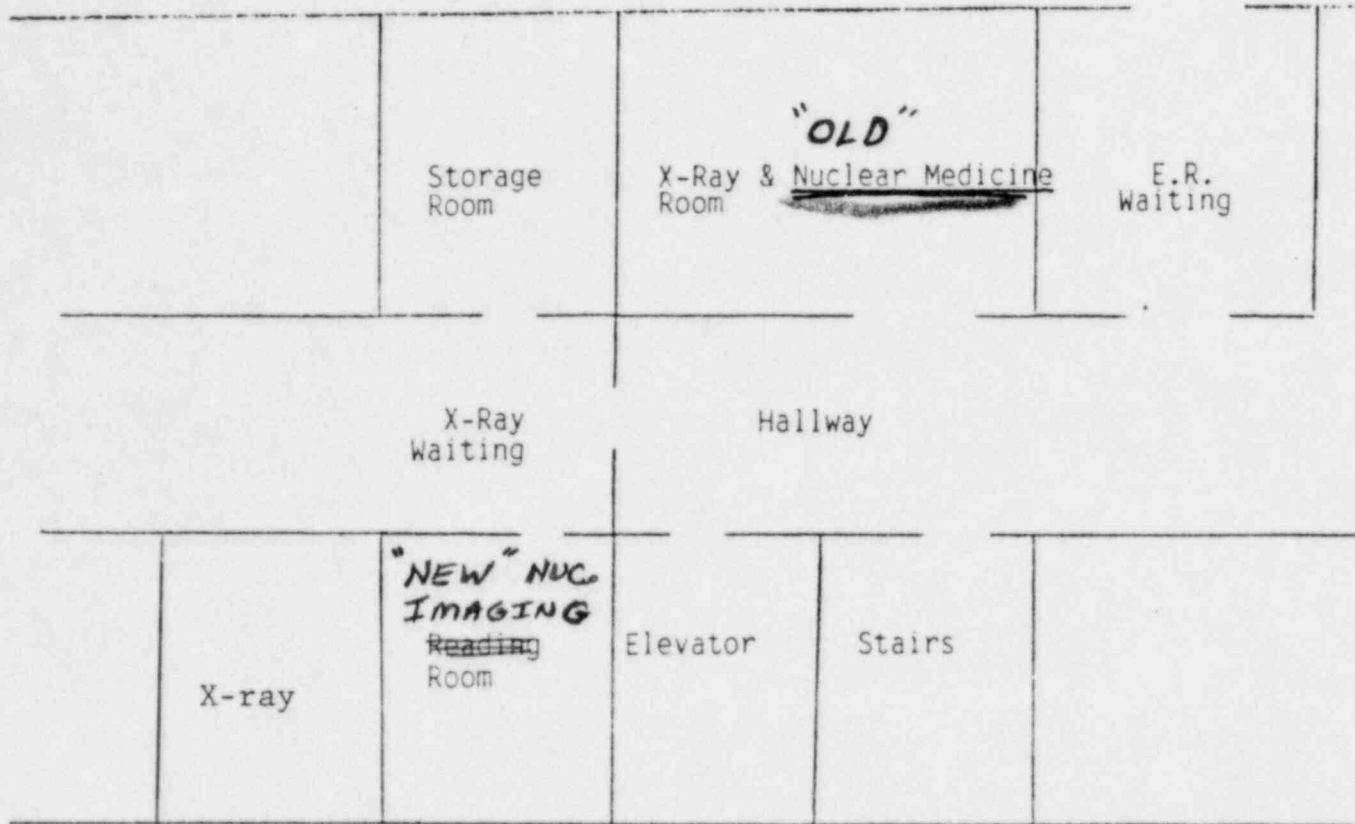
