

violation.

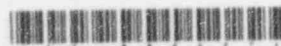
In accordance with the foregoing, payment of the proposed
