
Gentlemen:

In our current NRC License No. 04-17862-01 dated 2-17-83, we stated that all radioactive material would be received in Room 1B-43 (#13 p. 1, 2-13-83). This was so damaged or leaking material could be isolated prior to being taken to other areas of the Hospital.

We would like to amend this procedure to institute a second receiving log book whereby shipments of radioactive material received for the Nuclear Medicine Service would be brought directly to Nuclear Medicine (Room 4E-37) on the fourth floor and logged into our system there. It is felt that this will save our technicians considerable time which could be better spent working with patients or performing other duties requiring their technical skills.


