Dear Sirs:

This letter represents a formal request by B.P.B. INSTRUMENTS, INC. for an amendment to our existing license, (number 13-17342-01), to include new permanent storage and operations facilities in Shawnee, OK. The radioactive sources to be utilized at this facility are identical to those designated under AMENDMENT 10 of our existing license.

Operations are to be conducted in the same manner as indicated on our existing license, at a suitable facility to be located at:

903 E. 35th St.
Shawnee, OK. 74801

We therefore request an amendment to CONDITION 10 of AMENDMENT 9, (dated July 28, 1982), to include the addition of this new facility.

An amendment to CONDITION 12 of AMENDMENT 10, (dated April 18, 1983), is also requested, to add the following individuals to the approved list of eligible persons permitted to handle the sources being utilized. These individuals are: Robert Cox, Garland Peters, David Farmer, and Joseph Hall. A separate enclosure should provide the necessary background information concerning experience, which you may require.

Underground pit storage will be utilized and will be secured by lock inside the building. A separate enclosure is included, to indicate relative location of the pit inside the building, dimensions, etc.

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The pit will be divided into two separate chambers by a six (6) inch concrete block wall and will have two separate covers to allow independent access to each chamber. Overall interior

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dimensions of the pit are as follows: 80 inches in overall length, (includes both chambers) X 35 inches in width X 72 inches in total depth. The sources will remain in their approved transport carriers while stored in the pit.

With the exception of the requested changes to existing AMENDMENTS 9 and 10 of license number 13-17342-01, no other CONDITIONS as outlined within the license should require modification.

The training class was conducted in Liberal, KS. This session was a two day class given in May, 1982. All topics listed above were covered.

JOHN BUTLER - Field Engineer

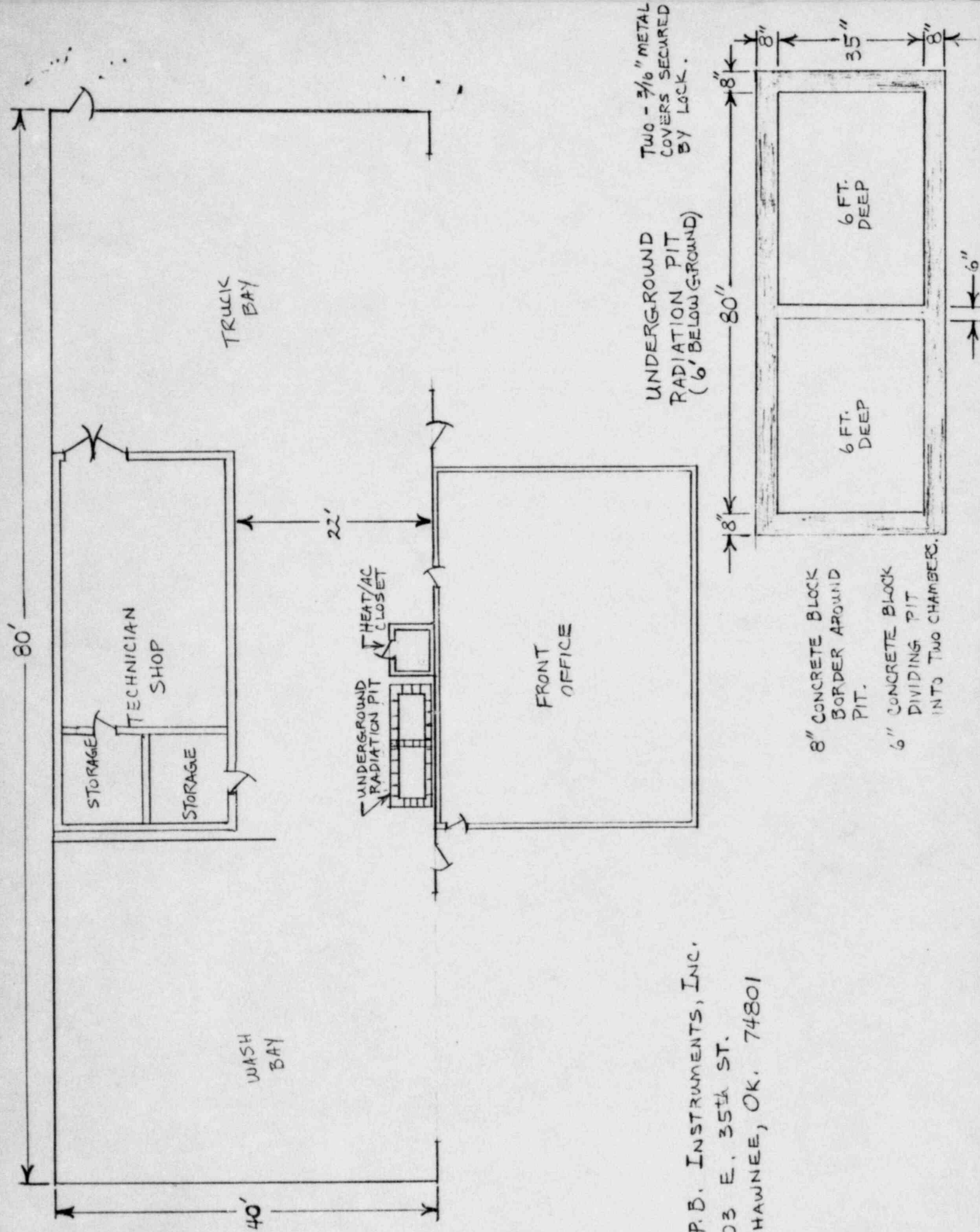
