Dear Mr. Horne:

This refers to the letter dated March 5, 1997, from Colonel Patrick T. Thornton in response to our letter dated February 21, 1997. We understand that you are the point of contact for the assessment of the potential exposure of persons involved in demilitarization of items containing licensed material at the Fort Irwin and the Defense Reutilization and Marketing Office (DRMO), Barstow, California in January, 1997. The letter also provided a brief description of the plan for the assessment. We understand from the letter that you have already implemented the plan. Although some results of the evaluation were provided in the letter, we expect the complete results will be included in the report due to our office on April 25, 1997.

Because your final report will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room (PDR), to the extent possible, it should not include any personal privacy information (such as names, social security numbers, dates of birth, etcetera) so that it can be placed in the PDR without redaction. If personal privacy information is necessary to provide an acceptable response, then please provide a separate and detachable part of the report which provides this information, similar to reports of exposures which are required to be reported pursuant to 10 CFR 20.2202.
