SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION AND NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Ms. Santin:

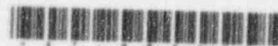
This refers to the inspection conducted on February 24 and 25, 1997 with continued in-office review through March 14, 1997 at Fairview Health System's Franklin Blvd. facility. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. At the conclusion of the site inspection, the findings were discussed with you and members of your staff. This also refers to separate telephone conversations Mr. Wayne Slawinski of my staff had with you on March 17, 1997 and Mr. Rick Urban on March 14, 1997, at which time additional information was obtained and the inspection concluded.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, independent measurements and observation of activities in progress.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that violations of NRC requirements occurred. These violations are cited in the enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice). A written response is required.

We are continuing the review of an October 18, 1994 incident involving the administration of sodium iodide I-131 for a whole body scan, to determine whether it constitutes a misadministration as defined in 10 CFR 35.2. We are also continuing to review your Quality Management Program for this incident, to determine if it was appropriately implemented. You will be advised in a separate correspondence of our decision regarding these matters.
