This is in reference to your letters dated February 21, 1997, and March 8, 1997, providing a revised Emergency Response Plan (EP) and Radiological Contingency Plan (RCP) updated through June 1996 in accordance with 10 CFR 40.35(f). We understand that the revision places in one manual both your EP that complies with OSHA's, "Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response Standard" and NRC Emergency Plan (RCP) requirements. We agree with your determination that combining the two Emergency Plans into one manual and cross referencing between the two plan does not decrease the effectiveness of your RCP.

We will for NRC convenience amend License No. SUB-526 at the time of the next license amendment to ensure that the license reflects the most current version of the RCP.
