Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 04 to your License Number 48-20331-01.

As discussed during our phone conversation on November 6, 1985, we have not authorized all you requested. The items not authorized are as follows:

1. Adding Memorial Hospital of Dodgeville to Condition 10.A.
2. Allowing free Tc-99m to be brought to Dodgeville for kit preparation or allowing storage of material at Dodgeville overnight.
3. Drs. Wentz, Grobin or Swingle as authorized users.

Item 1:

We do not currently authorize mobile medical services to establish a hot lab on the premises of a medical institution, therefore we are not able to list Memorial Hospital in Condition 10.A. You may want to consider this when your renewal is due, in view of your hot lab now located in Stoughton Hospital.

Item 2:

Mobile nuclear medicine services are licensed only for preparation of radiopharmaceuticals at a base location and the transport of unit doses or multi-unit doses to temporary job sites and must remove all waste material at the end of each visit in accordance with 10 CFR 35.12. Therefore, we did not authorize your request in item 4.

Item 3:

We will need the following information:

- a. For Dr. Wentz:

The New York license which was sent in expired on April 30, 1980. We will need evidence of Dr. Wentz's continuing experience with nuclear medicine procedures from 1980 to the present.

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b. For Dr. Grobin:

No preceptor was enclosed. Please submit a completed Supplement A and B outlining Dr. Grobin's experience or submit the license number of the hospital where Dr. Grobin was listed as an authorized user of byproduct material. Please note that the experience must have been within the past five years.

c. For Dr. Swingle

Unfortunately, Dr. Swingle's name was not listed on Gunderson Clinic's license. Please submit a completed Supplement A and B and evidence of his continuing involvement in nuclear medicine procedures within the past five years.
