The amendment requested includes the following changes:

2. Revise "Ship To" address in Appendix 1, Use of Radioisotopes, page 7 of Radiation Safety Guide to read:

Pennington, New Jersey 08534
to coincide with Amendment #3, approved July 22, 1983.
3. Increase the number of locations within the facility where by-product materials will be used and/or stored. Room numbers to be added are #171, 241, 241A, 241B, 241E and adjacent Locker/Shower rooms, 243, 243A, 243B, 243C, 245, 247, 252, 254, 256, 258, 260, 262, Locker/Shower rooms between 301 and 302, 313, 315, 317, 330, 407, 410, 416, 418, 420, 422, 424, 426, 428, 430, 432, 434, 523, 523A, 523B, 523C, 525 and 525B (see attached Floor Plan. Those areas designated in yellow are authorized use areas in accordance with Amendment #3. Those areas designated in pink are identified in this amendment request.) All use areas have non-porous surfaces such as stainless steel and composite surfaces and environmental controls such as exhaust hoods.
4. Change the name of the supplier of personnel monitoring devices from Siemens, Inc. to Health Physics Services, Inc.


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
