


We have an urgent need to amend our NRC Broad A License #48-01183-01 to raise our possession limit for Mo-99/Tc-99m generators from three (3) to five (5) Curies. Since 29 August 1983 we have been operating under a timely renewal of this license while our renewal application (Docket #030-03418, Control #15688) is being processed. This new limit is included in the renewal application.

The three Curie limit is now totally inadequate to meet our needs. Since we operate on a quarterly bid purchasing system and the new quarter starts 1 July 1985, we would like the limit raised immediately.

We were inspected by the NRC on 23 April 1985, with no violations cited. At that time, the inspector said there should be no problem expediting this increase given the situation.
