SUBJECT: GI 116, ACCIDENT MANAGEMENT

I agree that this issue is high priority, but do not agree with the disposition as stated in the conclusion. This is not research, we intend that licensees eventually will do something. I recommend that this issue should be listed as a high priority generic safety issue so that the discipline and tracking imposed by GIMCS would apply. An approved Task Action Plan should be developed and reviewed and approved by NRR and RES.

Absent this, the conclusion should at least be revised to indicate the issue is subsumed into the Accident Management Program, which includes work by both RES and NRR and actions by licensees and not just research activities. The Commission paper on Severe Accident Integrated Plan, SECY 88-147, which discusses the accident management program, and the supplement to GL 88-20 which discusses accident management should be referenced.
