SUBJECT: SAFETY CONCERNS ASSOCIATED WITH PIPE BREAKS IN THE BWR SCRAM
SYSTEM (GENERIC LETTERS 81-34 AND 86-01)

Re: Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station

On August 31, 1981, the staff issued Generic Letter (GL) 81-34, "Safety Concerns Associated with Pipe Breaks in the BWR Scram System", to all BWR licensees of operating reactors including Oyster Creek. In the GL, the staff requested plant specific information conforming to the guidance in NUREG-0803, "Generic SER Regarding Integrity of BWR Scram System Piping."

You submitted by letter dated March 24, 1982, the response to GL 81-34 for Oyster Creek. You stated, based on the review of NUREG-0803, that all of the concerns in the NUREG were being addressed in the staff's Systematic Evaluation Program and concluded that it was not necessary to take any further actions.

On January 3, 1986, the staff issued GL 86-01 which completes the staff's review of the safety concerns associated with pipe breaks in the BWR scram system. The staff plans no further action on the BWR scram system at Oyster Creek as part of GL 81-34. This letter closes out the staff's actions on GL 81-34.
