In accordance with letter dated November 6, 1985, License Number 06-13022-02 is amended as follows:

Condition 10. is amended to read:

10. A. Licensed material shall be used only at University of Connecticut Health Center, Farmington, Connecticut.
- B. The licensee may also use licensed material listed in Subitems 6.F., 6.H., 6.I., 6.J., and 6.L. at the Capital Region Mental Health Center, 2 Holcomb Street, Hartford, Connecticut, and the Red Cross Blood Center, 209 Farmington Avenue, Farmington, Connecticut, in accordance with letter dated July 28, 1980; and in Buildings 5 and 17 at the Veterans Administration Medical Center, 555 Willard Avenue, Newington, Connecticut, for research and development as defined by 10 CFR 30.4(q) and in vitro studies in accordance with letter dated April 19, 1983.
- C. The licensee may also use the iodine 125 source of 300 millicuries in a Norland Model 178A591A bone mineral analyser authorized under Subitem 6.R., for bone mineral determinations on humans at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material. The licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of a physician.
