Dear Sir:

This letter is to inform you that as of January 1, 1986, organizational changes within Boston Edison Company have been made that affect Section 6.2 of the Pilgrim Station Technical Specifications (Ref. 1). Section 6.2 requires a letter be sent to the NRC within 30 days of the date of the changes. This letter serves as the notice of change in organization.

The changes made are as follows:

1. The Nuclear Management Services Department (NMSD) has been expanded to include the former Planning, Scheduling and Cost Control Department. This Department (NMSD) will continue to report to the Vice President-Nuclear Engineering and Quality Control.
2. The Training Department (NTD) and the Nuclear Operations Support Department (NOSD) have been incorporated into the Nuclear Operations Department (NOD). NOD and Outage Management continue to report to the Vice President-Nuclear Operations.

NOD now consists of a Department Manager (NOM) and five section managers. The five sections are Technical, Radiological, Maintenance, Operations, and Management Services.


