Subject: Export license XSNM-02011 - Amendment

Ref.: Transnuclear Inc. application TNP-429 of December 17, 1985

Dear Mr. Thorne:

With reference to our letters of July 6, 1983, May 8, 1984, March 12, 1985 and May 6, 1985 we kindly ask you to amend the export license XSNM-02011 as follows:

Increase the quantities

from 48 kgs of U-235 contained in 1200 kgs of uranium
in the form of uranium hexafluoride as "heels",
enriched to 4.0 % maximum,

to 120 kgs of U-235 contained in 3000 kgs of uranium,
in the form of uranium hexafluoride as "heels",
enriched to 4.0 % maximum.

The above material will be subject to all terms and conditions of the Additional Agreement for Cooperation dated July 25, 1960 as amended, inclusive the exemption provisions of its Art. I bis E (1).

All other data of our above letters remain unchanged.
