Gentlemen:

This refers to your letter dated January 17, 1985, for renewal of Materials License SNM-714.

Section 170.11(a)(9) of Part 170, copy enclosed, provides that no fees will be required for "A license for possession and use of byproduct material, source material, or special nuclear material applied for by, or issued to, an agency of a State or any political subdivision thereof." Among the exceptions to this exemption, however, are licenses which authorize services to any person other than an agency or political subdivision of the State. Therefore, a renewal fee of \$120 is required as specified in fee Category 1J of §170.31 for the portion of your license authorizing calibration service for other licensees. Payment should be made to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and mailed to my attention at our Washington, D.C. address.

Your application will be processed by the Region I Licensing staff located at 631 Park Avenue, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406. The fee, however, is required prior to issuance of the renewal. When submitting the fee, please refer to CONTROL NUMBER 03360.
