Milhoan presented the St Lucie \$50,000 enforcement discretion for agreement to Taylor this morning, but Taylor does not agree (yet). Taylor had a range of technical questions related to the "multiple missed opportunities", which seemed to imply that FP&L had performed the "reasonable" maintenance & testing expected/required of the facilities. Accordingly, for Milhoan to readdress the issue, we need a brief listing of the missed opportunities that provides enough detail to demonstrate the failures. Also, to address numerous Taylor questions, we need an explanation of the ASME Code background - applicability, testing, results, etc.
