Gentlemen:

I am enclosing an Application for Byproduct Material License in the name of Newport City Real Estate Development Corp. The application is for the purchase of the Scentor, a portable gas chromatograph which contains a maximum of 150 millicuries of Hydrogen 3. I have also included a copy of our License No. 29-20512-01, Amendment No. 3, as the manufacturer of the instrumentation involved.

The instrumentation is to be used at the Newport City Project, 210 acres located along the waterfront in Jersey City, New Jersey. During the course of the construction, ground water has come to the surface and it is feared that the ground water may contain potential contaminants (especially, benzene) that may endanger the surrounding neighborhoods. It is for that reason that I am requesting, if possible, an immediate response to this application. If potential health hazards are involved, it is imperative, both for the developer and the various municipal agencies in Jersey City, New Jersey to take corrective action as soon as possible. The Scentor, when delivered, will be used to test the ground water that is being exposed during the course of this construction project.
