SUBJECT: WITHDRAWAL OF RES OFFICE LETTER NO. 3, "PROCEDURE AND
GUIDANCE FOR THE RESOLUTION OF GENERIC ISSUES"

The generic issue process consists of six phases: Identification, Prioritization, Resolution, Imposition, Implementation, and Verification. RES Office Letter No. 3 (OL-3) was first issued on May 10, 1988, to delineate the procedure for the resolution of generic issues. This followed the NRC reorganization in April 1987 when the functional responsibility for the early stages of generic issue management was transferred from NRR to RES. Subsequently, OL-3, Revision 1, was issued on December 21, 1988, and OL-3, Revision 2, was issued on March 27, 1989. The purpose of this notice is to inform you of the withdrawal of OL-3 since the procedure for the resolution of generic issues has been incorporated into OL-1, Revision 4.
