Enclosed please find a letter dated January 23, 1986 from Braunkohle Transport USA requesting a license to export to Switzerland 10,000 kilograms of solid depleted uranium plates. The material will be exported to the CER Laboratory in Switzerland where it will be used for experimental testing in a calorimeter.

Although the proposed export normally would not require Executive Branch review under current interagency procedures, NRC would appreciate Executive Branch views on the proposed license, in accordance with established procedures, because of recent concerns regarding shipments of source material.
