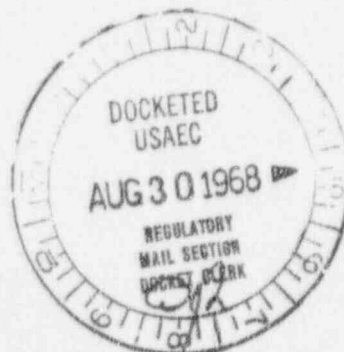

On August 23, 1968, a survey was made of the I-Line area drain gutters with a Geiger counter. All readings averaged less than 0.02 millirems per hour at a distance of one centimeter from the surface. A reading of this magnitude is just above background level.

All areas used in the DMM operations have now been checked for radiation after clean up. All areas were found to be well below the radioactivity contamination limits set by the A.F.C. for transfer and use of the buildings and equipment.

All radioactive scrap material has been placed in the approved burial area.
