TERMINATION OF AEC SOURCE MATERIAL LICENSE NO. SUB-143, KERR-MCGEE
OIL INDUSTRIES, INC., GOLDEN, COLORADO

The above subject license authorized Kerr-McGee Oil Industries, Inc., to conduct pilot plant studies of uranium ore processing at Golden, Colorado. By letter dated January 30, 1964, we informed the licensee that License No. SUB-143 would expire on March 30, 1964. By letter dated February 12, 1964, the licensee informed us that work had been discontinued at Golden and that renewal of the license was not being requested. A "Certification of Status of Source Material Activities Under United States Atomic Energy Commission License No. SUB-143" was submitted with the letter of February 12, 1964.

By letter dated March 16, 1964, we informed the licensee of contamination limits, etc., which should be met prior to termination of the license by the Commission. By letter dated June 3, 1964, the licensee notified us that surveys had been conducted showing that our contamination levels had been met. A copy of this report has been forwarded to the Region IV Compliance Office.

The purpose of this memo is to request a final inspection of the subject facility to determine whether or not Kerr-McGee has adequately represented the present situation with regard to contamination levels, etc., in the letter of June 3, 1964.
