Subject: Annual Update, Quality Assurance Topical Report (CENPD-210-A)

Dear Mr. Craig:


The NRC's regulations in 10 CFR 50.54 (a)(3) allow licensees to submit changes to previously accepted Quality Assurance Programs when the changes are minor and do not reduce commitments made to NRC. Based on a letter from Mr. J. N. Grace of the NRC to me dated October 16, 1984, NRC approved Combustion Engineering's request to submit similar changes to their program annually, in January, consistent with 10 CFR 50.54 (a)(3).

Attached are the revised organization charts depicting changes made to Combustion Engineering's Power Systems Group since our last submittal. These figures (17-1, 2, 3, 4, 5 dated January, 1986) will replace the existing figures in the current version of the topical report. Although they are extensive in appearance, they are streamlining in nature. They are considered minor revisions in that they do not reduce previously made commitments and they maintain the same fundamental relationships and independence stated in prior commitments. They do not eliminate any quality related activities nor do they reduce the program's effectiveness.

Unless Combustion Engineering hears from your office within 60 days, we will consider these changes accepted [10 CFR 50.54 (a)(3)] and issue the changes to all manual holders. If you have any questions on this topic, please feel free to contact me or Mr. J. E. Rogers of my staff at (203) 285-5204.
