Co. Division ("Marmon"), under the terms of NRC Byproduct Material License No. 35-14942-01. As you know, on May 28, 1982, Marmon timely applied to the NRC for renewal of License No. 35-14942-01. Since that time, Applicant and Marmon have entered into negotiations for the purchase of the assets of the company from Marmon by Applicant. As the result of very recent discussions, Marmon and Applicant have tentatively consummated those negotiations and plan to effect the sale at a closing to be held next Tuesday, August 21, 1982. For this reason, Applicant respectfully asks the NRC to give expedited consideration to the enclosed application so that the closing may proceed as planned.

We note that the enclosed application addresses all the questions you raised in your letter to Marmon dated June 29, 1982, relative to the facilities in question. In all other respects, the facilities, procedures and radiographers are the same as those now licensed under License No. 35-14942-01. Based on Mr. Fitzgerald's discussions with you to date, we understand that Applicant has now addressed all applicable technical requirements. If this is not the case, we would greatly appreciate your contacting Mr. Fitzgerald after your review of the enclosed application so that Applicant can make any necessary modifications.

Although Applicant appreciates the special nature of its request for expedited review, we stress that NRC review and approval of this application by the close of business on Monday, August 30, 1982, is necessary to avoid severe economic hardship to Applicant.
