Dear Sir:

On September 16, 1985, we committed to provide a followup report on our analysis of the potential deficiency caused by an error in the GT STRUDL computer program.

We have completed our evaluation of a sample 25 computer runs potentially effected by this error. The results of this evaluation indicate that these 25 support designs are not impacted by this error.

We are in the process of completing a generic evaluation of this problem for all other potentially effected support designs. In addition, a larger sample of support designs is being specifically evaluated to further confirm our evaluation.

We expect these items will be completed and a final report issued by January 15, 1986.
