Submitting Hearing File)


Upon consideration of the March 14, 1997 hearing request of Frank J. Calabrese Jr. challenging the NRC staff's denial of his senior reactor operator's (SRO) license application and the staff's April 7, 1997 response to that hearing request, it is

ORDERED, that Mr. Calabrese's March 14, 1997 hearing request is granted; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that on or before Thursday, May 8, 1997, the staff shall file the hearing file in this proceeding, which shall be served on Mr. Calabrese by express mail or made available to him by other means that ensure he will have access to the hearing file by the next business day; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that on or before Friday, April 18, 1997, the staff shall file a pleading that provides an estimate of the length (in pages) of the hearing file; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED, that on or before Wednesday, April 30, 1997, Mr. Calabrese shall file a pleading that provides his estimate of how long he will need to review the hearing file and prepare and file his written presentation containing his arguments, and any accompanying documentation and affidavits, in support of his challenge to the validity of the staff's denial of his SRO application.
