

Dear Administrative Judges:

During the adjudicatory proceeding on the application of Georgia Power Company (GPC) to transfer the authority to operate its facility, the Board retained an original Office of Investigations (OI) evidence item, an audio cassette labeled Tape 58, and an enhanced copy of that tape.
