In accordance with letter dated February 27, 1984, License Number 34-03831-02 is amended as follows:

Condition 17. is amended to read:

17. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated April 26, 1979; letter received August 1, 1979; and letters dated August 10, 1979, May 30, 1980, August 5, 1981, September 28, 1981, October 1, 1982, December 8, 1982, September 22, 1983, December 1, 1983, February 27, 1984, and April 3, 1984. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.

Condition 21. is added:

21. Pursuant to Sections 20.106(b) and 20.302, 10 CFR 20, the licensee is authorized to dispose of licensed material by incineration provided the gaseous effluent from incineration does not exceed the limits specified for air in Appendix B, Table II, 10 CFR 20. Ash residues may be disposed of as ordinary waste provided appropriate surveys pursuant to Section 20.201 are made to determine that concentrations of licensed material appearing in the ash residues do not exceed the concentrations (in terms of microcuries per gram) specified for water in Appendix B, Table II, 10 CFR 20.
