On March 21, 1997, regulatory jurisdiction over the Engelhard facility in Plainville, MA, was transferred to the Massachusetts Department of Public Health when the Commonwealth became an Agreement State under Section 274 of the Atomic Energy Act. The Massachusetts contact is Mr. Robert Hallisey, who can be reached at 617-727-6214, extension 6872.

As you are aware, the Engelhard facility is listed in the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Site Decommissioning Management Plan (SDMP). It is our intent to remove the Engelhard site from SDMP now that NRC no longer has regulatory jurisdiction over the radioactive material being managed at the Plainville site.
