P R O C E E D I N G S

CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Good afternoon ladies and gentlemen. This is an affirmation/discussion session. We have two items planned for action this afternoon. I will ask the Secretary to lead us through the two items.

SECRETARY CHILK: Before we go that, Mr. Chairman, I wonder if the Commission will vote to hold these two items, 85-338A dealing with Pilgrim and 85-370 dealing with Fort St. Vrain on less than one week's notice.

CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: This having to do with equipment qualification.

SECRETARY CHILK: This has to do with equipment qualifications.

(Chorus of ayes.)

SECRETARY CHILK: The first one is 85-370, an order regarding equipment qualification extension of a November 30, 1985 deadline for Fort St. Vrain Nuclear Generating Station.

The Commission here is being asked to act on the order responding to a request to extend the deadline for environment qualification of Fort St. Vrain Nuclear Generating Station from November 30, 1985 to May 31, 1986.

The Commission is also being asked to empower the director of NRR to authorize operation of Fort St. Vrain at up to 35 percent of full power through May 31, 1986.

The Director's authority would be contingent upon

1 finding that the confirmatory submittals from the licensee are
2 acceptable.

3 All Commissioners have approved the extension of the
4 EQ deadline to May 31, 1986 and to empower the Director of NRR
5 to authorize contingent on a finding that the confirmatory
6 submittals are acceptable the operation of Fort St. Vrain at
7 up to 35 percent of full power through May 31, 1986.

8 Would you please affirm your votes?

9 (Chorus of ayes.)

10 SECRETARY CHILK: The second item is 85-338A. It
11 deals with the environmental qualification extension request
12 for Pilgrim.

13 The Commission here is being asked to act on an
14 order responding to a request also to extend from November 30,
15 1985 to February 8, 1986 the deadline for environmental
16 qualification at the Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station.

17 The Chairman, Commissioners Bernthal and Asselstine
18 disapprove the extension of the EQ deadline.

19 Commissioner Roberts and Zech would extend the time
20 frame for documentation. Commissioner Zech would also extend
21 the time frame for equipment testing.

22 The exact wording of the order will be coordinated
23 with Commission offices since we have not had it before you
24 prior to approval.

25 Would you please affirm your votes?

1 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: May I ask a question? Does the
2 order have to be affirmed?

3 SECRETARY CHILK: Marty, does the order have to be
4 affirmed?

5 MR. MALSCH: I think our plan would be that the
6 bottom line would be affirmed today. We would simply circulate
7 the order.

8 SECRETARY CHILK: Circulate the order for the words.

9 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: All right. Thank you.

10 SECRETARY CHILK: Would you please affirm your
11 votes?

12 (Chorus of ayes.)

13 SECRETARY CHILK: Thank you.

14 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: Anything more to come before
15 us?

16 SECRETARY CHILK: I have nothing further,
17 Mr. Chairman.

18 CHAIRMAN PALLADINO: All right. Thank you. We will
19 stand adjourned.

20 (Whereupon, the Commission was adjourned at 4:20
21 o'clock p.m., to reconvene at the Call of the Chair.)
