We understand the Invoice 0123V for Inspection Services is due and payable as of 3/28/85. We expect to honor the invoice.

However, we have come to the decision to suspend use of the isotope as of 4/8/85 and store it on the premises along with our other discontinued and stored source Cs137.


Since our operating licenses does not expire until April 30, 1987, we would like to maintain that on inactive status until such time as we would want to reactivate our use of Ir 192 or discontinue it altogether, within the time period 4/30/87.

Likewise we would expect future audit be held up until such time as we requested reactivation.

Deactivation is a result of:

1. Lack of business.
2. High cost of maintaining a relatively strong (active) source.
3. Inspection (audit) fee (\$980.00) For our limited use this we feel is excessive. There seems to be no consideration for the small operator.
