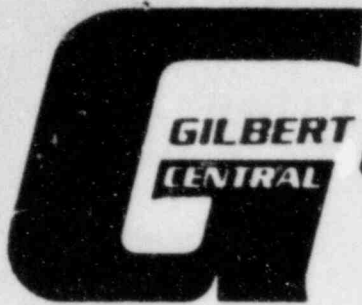

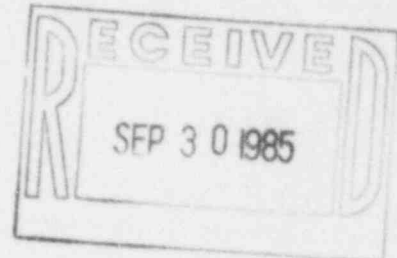

Violation No. 4


1. Reason - We were not aware of this condition.

Violation No. 5

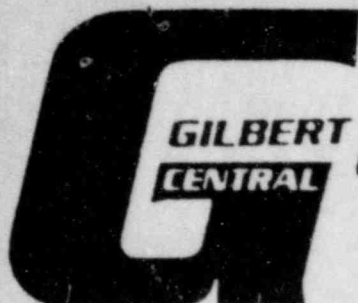
1. Reason - We were not aware of this condition.
