SUBJECT: NRC INSPECTION

Dear Mr. Burgess:

This refers to the inspection conducted on March 24, 1997 at St. Francis Hospital, Escanaba, Michigan. The purpose of the inspection was to determine whether activities authorized by the license were conducted safely and in accordance with NRC requirements. At the conclusion of the inspection, the findings were discussed with you and members of your staff.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, independent measurements and observation of activities in progress.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified during the course of the inspection conducted on March 24, 1997.

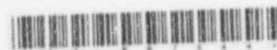
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
