Dear Sir:

The enclosed application is provided as a request to renew and amend License SNM-180. Renewal period requested is five (5) years. Changes in the application from previous submittal are:

- a) Building 10 of Balcones Research Center has been removed for use or storage of materials.
- b) Personnel changes at the support or technician level have occurred.

Amendments in the license terminology requested are:

- a) Allowance for periodic calibration of survey instruments at intervals not to exceed eight (8) months. This calibration period conforms to the six (6) month not to exceed 8 months applied to the license R-92 also maintained by the laboratory.
- b) Allowance for temporary use of PuBe sources at other locations for experimental purposes. A typical application would be the calibration of neutron measurement equipment or neutron survey meters.

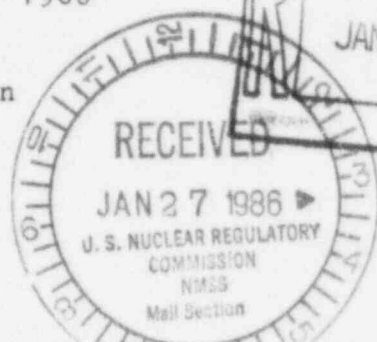
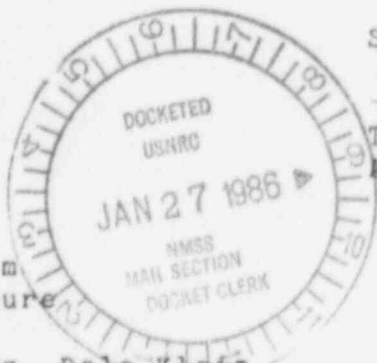
