Condition 10. is amended to add:

10. L. The licensee is authorized to possess and use a maximum of 240 microcuries of Hydrogen-3 at the Potter Preserve, Baraboo Hills, Wisconsin in accordance with statements and procedures contained in Letter dated November 11, 1985.

Condition 21. is amended to read:

21. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in applications dated January 24, 1979 and September 30, 1980; and letters dated February 6, 1980, December 19, 1980, April 1, 1981, October 6, 1981, February 23, 1982, April 14, 1982, October 14, 1982, March 21, 1984 (with attachments), November 15, 1984, April 30, 1985, May 30, 1985 and November 11, 1985. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.

SUMMARY

amendment request dated 11/1/85: field study using and releasing H-3 in wild free birds. (using 250 microcuries)

I called to determine whether a Technical Assistance Request for Part 51 environmental assessment was necessary for this request. It is almost identical to another study requested by the University in April 1985. An assistance request was made on this previous case with the result being a memo from V. Miller stating the field study using 1mc H-3 would have negligible impact & falls within the categorical exclusion in section 51.22(b)(14)(v) of 10CFR Part 51. St Mary ~~confirmed~~ discussed the situation with John Hickey and who said it would not be necessary to submit another technical assistance request on this amendment & that since ~~this was~~ this was so similar to the previous situation the same conclusions apply: It falls within categorical exclusion of section 51.22.
