Dear Mr. Chairman:

This letter is in response to your January 3, 1986 request for a postponement of the upcoming Nuclear Regulatory Commission meeting now scheduled for January 9, 1986 with the TVA Board.

As I indicated to you by telephone on the afternoon of January 3, the meeting should go ahead as scheduled on January 9. I also indicated that you should focus on: (1) a review of the history, from your vantage point, leading up to the current situation at TVA's nuclear facilities; and (2) an identification of the major issues, as you currently see them, in an effort to develop a common understanding by both of our agencies on what the problems are. I suggested that you could add any status remarks as you see fit.

If another meeting between us is needed later in January or at some future time, we can arrange for it at a later date.
