Reference BML License 12-00722-13 issued May 23, 1984, and
BML License 12-00722-11 issued March 6, 1984.

Condition 14 of the -13 license and condition 15 of the -11
license each require a physical inventory annually.

The items covered by these two licenses are fielded
throughout the world. It is not possible for the licensee to
visit each location and conduct a physical inventory. However,
for the -11 license, wipe test reports are submitted to this
headquarters every 6 months, and these results are maintained on
file permanently. For the -13 license, the owner will be
required to submit a computer transaction card indicating serial
number and location of each unit annually. These records will be
maintained for 2 years.

Request confirmation by your office that the above actions
will satisfy the conditions of subject licenses in lieu of
physical inventories.
