By the April 5, 1985 letter from T. M. Novak to H. G. Parris, NRC transmitted to TVA the Safety Evaluation Report (SER) for the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant Inservice Testing (IST) Program for Pumps and Valves (P/V). As a result of telephone conversations and a July 2, 1985 meeting with NRC representatives, TVA submitted a revised P/V IST program for SQN units 1 and 2 on August 16, 1985 by letter from J. A. Damer to E. Adensam, as well as an item-by-item response to the SER for the P/V IST program. As stated in the July 2, 1985 meeting, the P/V IST program is scheduled to be fully implemented by startup from the cycle 3 refueling outages for each unit. This clarification was inadvertently omitted from the August 16, 1985 letter.
