MOTION OF NRC STAFF
FOR REVISION OF SCHEDULE

By order dated January 24, 1986, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board approved a revised schedule for this proceeding as follows:

- February 14, 1986 - complete depositions;
- February 24, 1986 - file written direct testimony;
- March 6, 1986 - file any motions to strike testimony;
- March 17, 1986 - file responses to motions to strike; and
- March 31, 1986 - commence hearing.

That revision to the schedule was necessitated by the unavailability of Staff witnesses Drs. Cool and Shum for depositions on the previously established schedule. Although at that time the Staff believed that Drs. Cool and Shum would be available for depositions by February 14, their responsibilities with respect to analyses of the January 4, 1986 accident at Kerr-McGee's Sequoyah Facility have not permitted them sufficient time to prepare for depositions by February 14.

The NRC staff has discussed these considerations with Kerr-McGee, and the Staff and Kerr-McGee have agreed that the following revised schedule should be submitted for the Board's approval:

- March 21, 1986 - complete depositions;
- March 31, 1986 - file written direct testimony;
- April 10, 1986 - file any motions to strike testimony;
- April 21, 1986 - file responses to motions to strike testimony; and
- May 5, 1986 - commence hearing.

The Staff has also advised the People of the State of Illinois of this motion and they have indicated they neither concur in nor oppose the motion.

Accordingly, the Staff requests the Licensing Board to revise the schedule for this proceeding as set forth above.
