

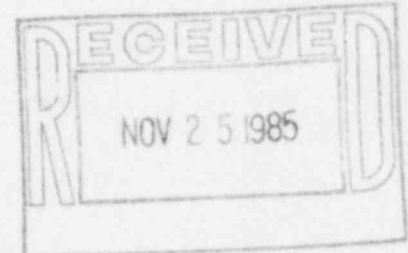

On September 20, 1985, we verbally notified your Mr. T. F. Westerman of a deficiency involving the transformers provided by Westinghouse as part of the 480V switchgear. These transformers include as accessories cooling fans and controls whose environmental qualification status has not been established. We have submitted an interim report logged TXX-4592, dated October 10, 1985. The evaluation for this issue includes environmental qualification and testing activities by Westinghouse which are scheduled for completion April 1, 1986.

We are continuing our evaluation and anticipate completion by April 29, 1986.
