COMMENTS:

1. The staff should perform a review of the DOE analyses to validate the conclusions drawn. If such an analysis has not been performed prior to publication in the Federal Register of the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, then the staff should instruct interested members of the public as to how copies of these analyses can be obtained.
2. If the reduced Pu concentration in the vitrified HLW is part of the justification for exemption of this form from the double containment requirements, then it should be a part of the regulatory requirements for this form. If not, the staff should so state.
3. The values and impacts section of the Regulatory Analysis should be expanded to explain the basis for the statements that loading and unloading time as well as occupational exposures will be reduced as a result of this action.
