In response to your letter of September 24, 1985, notifying our laboratory of the violation identified during inspection number 030-19430/85-01 conducted on April 22, 1985, the following corrective procedures have been implemented to assure compliance with NRC regulations.


Violation: 10 CFR 20.401(b)

Corrective Action Taken: Records are now being maintained for all radioactive waste that is being stored on the premises. The date of initiation of storage, estimated removal date and monthly radiation survey reading on each unit stored is now being documented. Monthly radiation survey readings are also being recorded for all areas within the Chemistry Department where radioactive testing is performed. (i.e. counters, sink, dishwasher, etc.)


Date of Full Compliance: Procedures were implemented May 1, 1985.
