1. Reference. USNRC BML No. 42-05255-08.
2. This letter is being submitted in lieu of NRC Form 314.
3. The Radiation Therapy Service, William Beaumont Army Medical Center (WBAMC) no longer exists.
4. The AECL Model Theratron-80 teletherapy unit, serial number 355 and the AECL Model C-146 Cobalt-60 source, serial number S-3443 (Encl 1) contained therein were donated to the State of Texas, Texas Surplus Property Agency by the General Services Administration (Encl 2).
5. The Texas Surplus Property Agency assigned this property to the El Paso Cancer Treatment Center, El Paso, Texas (Encl 3).
6. Final disposition of the teletherapy unit and the Cobalt-60 source was as follows:
 - a. The El Paso Cancer Treatment Center contracted with X-Ray Equipment Company, Fort Worth, Texas for removal of the unit and source from WBAMC.
 - b. The El Paso Cancer Treatment Center received the teletherapy unit at their facility under Agreement State License No. TX-3-1847 (Encl 4).

c. The X-Ray Equipment Company took possession of the Cobalt-60 source (Encl 5) under Agreement State License No. TX-5-1485 (Encl 6).

7 The WBAMC Radiation Protection Office performed area surveys and wipe tests of the teletherapy unit and the room in which it was located as follows:

a. The source drawer of AECL Model Theratron-80 Teletherapy unit, serial number 355, after the Cobalt-60 source was removed. Results were less than minimum detectable activity (MDA).

b. The room showed radiation levels equal to or less than background (0.01 mR/hr) and removable contamination less than MDA.

c. Instrumentation utilized consisted of:


(1) Ludlum, Model 3, Geiger Counter, Serial Number 6097, Calibrated 10 July 1985.

(2) Canberra, Model 8100, Multi Channel Analyzer, Serial Number A5269 with a Co-60 efficiency of 8% and a MDA of 4.56×10^{-4} microcuries.

8. Given the above information; WBAMC requests that the USNRC terminate its USNRC BML No. 42-05255-08 and allow WBAMC to release for general occupancy the room (Rm 1-232) in which the teletherapy unit was located.

MEASUREMENT METHOD

The source exposure rate was measured in the cell described on the following sheet (Form QC 9 Sheet 2).
The exposure rate was measured with an air wall cavity ionization chamber having a volume of 0.6 cm³
and fitted with a 4.6 mm lucite equilibrium cap. The instrument is calibrated in a cobalt-60 exposure rate
certified by the National Research Council of Canada.

ACCURACY

The uncertainty in the source exposure rate applies only to measurement of this source in the AECL
Measurement Cell. It represents the maximum total uncertainty due to all causes including the calibration
of the Council's primary exposure rate, the calibration of their instrumentation and the precision of mea-
surement in the Measurement Cell. Additional uncertainty due to the comparative measurements involved,
has been included in the statement of unit output.

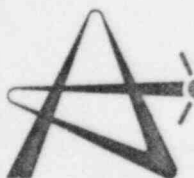
