Gentlemen:

Midwest Inspection Service, Ltd., License number 48-16296-01, respectfully submits the following termination reports in accordance with 10 CFR part 20.408(b).

I also request a commission clarification on termination reporting in certain instances at Midwest Inspection Service, Ltd.

Midwest Inspection Service, Ltd. has several projects (power plants, paper mills) where the control of access points to radiographic areas becomes very difficult, because of the number of entry points and time allotted to make the necessary exposures.

Access points on the floor where radiography is performed are roped and signed. Shift supervisor is notified and construction supervisors are notified. In addition, four floor walkers are utilized, two on floor above and two on floor below, with survey instruments.

Even though the area where walkers are utilized is less than 2mr per hour, for my safety I will film badge the walkers. Maximum length of employment per shut down is fourteen days. Dose-None.

The question of termination reports in this type of situation has arisen by the NRC audit inspector. He feels I should be issuing the report. I feel that I have only insured myself against a later exposure claim from an individual who was near a radiographic area.

Your consideration of this clarification is appreciated.
