Stratt, M.D. Licensed material in the New Jersey facility shall be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, John W. Bornhoeft, Ph.D., Bernard Neff, M.D. or Bruce J. Stratt, M.D.
15. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use licensed material described in Items 6, 7, and 8 of this license in accordance with statements, representations, and procedures contained in application dated August 12, 1983; and letters dated November 15, 1983, January 16, 1984 and July 16, 1985 (with attachments). The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern the licensee's statements in applications or letters, unless the statements are more restrictive than the regulations.
