Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 17 to your NRC License No. 12-15537-01 in accordance with your request.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. You must conduct your program involving radioactive materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:

1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.
2. Possess radioactive material only in the quantity and form indicated in your license.
3. Use radioactive material only for the purpose(s) indicated in your license.
4. Notify NRC in writing of any change in mailing address.
5. Request and obtain appropriate amendment if you plan to change ownership of your organization, change locations of radioactive material, or make any other changes in your facility or program which are contrary to your license conditions or representations made in your license application and any supplemental correspondence with NRC. Any amendment request should be accompanied by the appropriate fee specified in 10 CFR Part 170.
6. Submit a complete renewal application with proper fee or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date on your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of radioactive material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations.
7. Request termination of your license if you plan to permanently discontinue activities involving radioactive material prior to your expiration date.

REPORT OF RADIATION SURVEY

A radiation survey was conducted at the Seatt Corporation facility located at 5018 Chase Street, Downers Grove, Illinois, to determine levels of residual contamination and to isolate and correct any conditions in which contamination might be a problem.

The survey was made with a Victoreen Thyac III, Model 490, Radiation Survey Meter which was last calibrated by Health Physics Associates, Highland Park, Illinois, on February 28, 1985.

Procedure involved a careful sweeping of all surfaces which had been exposed in the normal course of activity, with the survey probe at or just above 1/16" from those surfaces. Checks were made on work benches, floors, desks, stools, chairs, shelves and in no instance did the indicated radiation level exceed the background level of approximately 200 cpm.

Previous Wipe Tests were conducted and discs submitted for counting to Health Physics Associates. The results did not indicate any presence of contamination.

Spot checks were made of accumulations of originally airborne dust found on infrequently used shelves, work surfaces, etc., and again, in no instance were any levels found in excess of background. No residual activity was found in any plumbing fixtures, drains and trays.

The lack of contamination is not unexpected considering that our sources are sealed and contained in holders, are large and easy to control, are small in Am²⁴¹ content (1.3uCi max.), and are small in number.

As added precaution, all work surfaces in areas used for handling sources have been washed with soap and water. Floors have been swept, and carpets vacuumed. No activity was found in any collected dust and dirt.

We are requesting an amendment to the above referenced licenses to show an additional three ionization smoke detectors for our Listee Jameson Home Products. The new models will be called CD-5, CD-23, and CD-24. CD-5 is identical to the present Jameson Home Products model number CD-3 with the following exception. This model will be promoted in the Market with a rebate offer.

CD-23 is identical to CD-24, the only difference is CD-24 will be promoted to the market with a rebate offer. Both CD-23 and CD-24 are constructed the same as the present Jameson Home Products CD-1 with the following exceptions. These two detectors will have a light that turns on when the detector is in the alarm mode, and the outside plastic enclosure is slightly larger than CD-1 enclosure.
